



## + Buttons





- 1. Power On/Off: Press and hold to turn the device on or off
- Display On/Off, Hold On/Off: Press the power button to turn off the screen and enable the Hold state. Press again to disable the Hold state and turn on the screen.

## Smart RESET

If the buttons and/or touchpad become unresponsive during use, press and hold the power button for approximately six seconds to reboot the device. The RESET function is a simple power cycling feature and does not negatively affect the device.

## + Power Connection and Charging



Connect iAUDIO E3 to a standard PC USB port using the provided Simple USB Connector.

The device is fully charged after approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes.



- Be sure to connect the device directly to a USB port located on the back of the PC. The device may be unable to establish a connection or be charged as the power supply from a form USB port or a non-powered external USB hub may be unstable.
   - Be sure to fully charge the device before using it for the first time or after an extended period of non-use.
- iAUDIO E3 uses a lithium-ion polymer battery. To extend the battery life, charge the device regularly rather than fully

discharging and recharging it.

## + Connecting and Disconnecting the PC

- 1. Use the Simple USB Connector to connect iAUDIO E3 to the PC.
- iAUDIO E3 displays the following image if properly connected to the PC.
- Also make sure to check My Computer or Windows Explorer to see if iAUDIO E3 is properly connected to the PC.
- 4. Copy desired video, music, or other files to iAUDIO E3.
- 5. When done, click the icon on the system tray to safely remove iAUDIO E3 from the PC.

- The player can recognize up to 2,048 folders and up to 2,048 files.

## + Firmware Upgrade

Firmware is software that is embedded within the hardware. Upgrading it can enhance system stability and provide additional features. Please be advised that Beta(unofficial) firmware versions may cause system malfunction.

- + How to upgrade the firmware
- 1. Download the latest firmware from the SUPPORT section of the website (http://www.COWON.com).
- 2. Use the Simple USB Connector to connect iAUDIO E3 to the PC.
- 3. Unzip the downloaded firmware and copy it to the root folder of iAUDIO E3.
- 4. Perform "Safely remove the hardware" function on your PC and disconnect the Simple USB Connector.
- 5. When you turn on the product, the firmware upgrade process will start.
- 6. Successful firmware upgrade can be confirmed by turning on the product, the version of firmware will be shown at start up.
- 7. The current firmware version can be checked in Settings Information.
- Fully charge the player before upgrading the firmware.
- Do not turn the player off before the firmware update has been completed. It may damage the product, and will void any warranty,
- Back up any important data before the firmware upgrade as any data stored on the device may be deleted during the process.



## Basic Use + FITNESS



- 1. Turn on iAUDIO E3 and select FITNESS mode.
- 2. Press the ►|| button to display the pedometer and calorie consumption at 4-second intervals.
- The song title, artist, and album names' tag information will be displayed sequentially at the bottom of the screen, and the exercise duration timer will be displayed thereafter.
- 4. Press and hold the ►II button, and select FITNESS to select the user's gender and weight Select Restart to reset the FITNESS mode.
- \* The number of steps appear after calculations since the G-sensor(Accelerometer) measures precise steps.

## + Troubleshooting

#### + I am still confused even after reading the manual.

COWON website(www.COWON.com) provides support for users of COWON products with FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions). Users are strongly encouraged to check out the website for further information regarding product usages and firmware upgrades. For individual inquiries, please contact us on-line as we will try to help you as best as we can.

#### + The player does not turn on.

Verify the battery level or that the device is connected to a power supply.

Charge the battery for a certain period and turn on iAUDIO E3 if the battery is completely discharged.

If the device is unresponsive or malfunctioning, press and hold the power button for six seconds to automatically reset the device.

If the display is turned off during use, the touchpad will not function. Press the power button to disable the Hold state and turn on the screen.

#### + I can't hear any sound.

Check if the volume is set to "0". Check if there is any file available in the player. If there is no file in the player, you will not hear any sound. Please note that corrupted files will result in a noise or discontinued playback. Make sure the earphones are connected properly, Impurities in the earphone jack can cause a noise

## + Files that I have stored do not appear in the list.

+ The touch pad and buttons do not work properly

Each mode shows you a list of playable files only. To view all files that you have stored, select the Browser mode. Please note that System folder will not appear in the Browser.

## Troubleshooting

## + Troubleshooting

## + There is too much noise in my recordings.

The product uses ultra-small internal microphone, so it may be more susceptible to noise during recordings. The microphone should not be covered with anything during recording.

#### + Characters on the display are corrupted.

Set your preferred language again in Settings > Language. If the problem pensists, set the current font to the system font. COWON products are developed based on the Korean Windows OS, and this may cause corruption of some special fonts or languages on the display.

## + Computer cannot recognize the player when connected.

Press and hold the power button for approximately exisconds to reboot the device, you experience a frequent disconnection or unstable connectivity, connect the player directly to the USB port of the PC, rather than a separate USB hub. As COWON products use the USB connection for the main power system, unstable power supply can cause a connection failure.

## + Memory capacity of the player is different or smaller than specified.

The memory capacity indicated by Windows may be different from that indicated by the memory manufacturer. The actual capacity will be reduced from the original size because some space of the memory should be used as the system area for normal operation.

## + The player does not play properly when memory is full.

For the player to function properly, it requires at least 10MB of space for saving settings and other system files.
